

Minecraft Server Player Setup Guide: Survival and Creative

This guide provides detailed instructions for players on how to join the **Survival and Creative** servers, including domain-based and direct IP connections. It also includes installation instructions for Bedrock players using **Geyser**, setting up voice chat, and using server commands.

Connection Information

Java Edition (Minecraft: Java Edition 1.21.4)

Players can connect using either the custom domain names or direct IP + ports:

- **Survival:** survival.ombminecraftserver.com (**Backup:** 51.81.209.158:25565)
- **Creative:** creative.ombminecraftserver.com (**Backup:** 51.81.209.158:25566)

Bedrock (Geyser) Player Connection






Bedrock Edition players can join the servers using **Geyser**, allowing crossplay with Java Edition servers.

1. Open **Minecraft: Bedrock Edition** (PC, Console, or Mobile).
2. Click **Play** → **Servers** → **Add Server**.
3. Enter the following details:
 - **Server Name:** [Omb Minecraft Server](#)
 - **Server Address:** [51.81.209.158](#)

- **Port:**
 - **Survival:** 19132
 - **Creative:** 19133
4. Click **Save** and join the game.

Mod & Plugin Features

All servers use **Fabric 1.21.4 (Survival & Creative) / 1.21.1 (Cobblemon)** with the following features:

-  **Commands:** `/home`, `/tpa`, `/spawn`, `/rtp`, `/back`
 -  **Live Map:** `/dynmap`
 -  **Proximity Voice Chat:** `/voicechat`
 -  **Claims & Party System:** `/openpac-claim`, `/openpac-party`
 -  **Crossplay Support (Geyser):** Bedrock players can join Java servers.

Proximity Voice Chat Setup (Simple Voice Chat)

The server uses **Simple Voice Chat**, allowing players to talk in-game with **proximity chat**.

Installation for Players

1. **Download the Mod**
 - Go to Modrinth or CurseForge.
 - Move the **Voice Chat .jar** file into your Minecraft **mods** folder.
 2. **Configure & Use**
 - Join the server and press **V** to **toggle voice chat**.
 - Adjust settings in **Options > Voice Chat**.

Server Commands

General Commands

Command

Description

<code>/spawn</code>	Teleports to spawn.
<code>/home</code>	Teleports to your home.
<code>/home set</code>	Sets your home location.
<code>/tpa <player></code>	Sends a teleport request to a player.
<code>/tpaccept</code>	Accepts a teleport request.
<code>/openpac-claim</code>	Protects land from griefing.
<code>/openpac-party</code>	Creates a party for group gameplay.
<code>/rtp</code>	Randomly teleports in the world.

Dynmap Commands

Command	Description
<code>/dynmap show</code>	Shows player on the map.
<code>/dynmap hide</code>	Hides player from the map.

Voice Chat Commands

Command	Description
<code>/voicechat</code>	Opens the voice chat settings.
<code>/mute <player></code>	Mutes a player.

How to Join the Server

All servers are **whitelisted** for security. Players need to be added to the whitelist before joining.

1. Ensure you're using **Minecraft 1.21.4 (Survival & Creative) or 1.21.1 (Cobblemon)**.
 2. Use the **custom domain names** or **backup IP + port** to connect.
 3. Once whitelisted, restart Minecraft and join the server.
